Occasionally, when there is heavy demand and/or low staff availability it may be necessary to withdraw tickets earlier than 30 minutes prior to the normal closing time (this will only be done in exceptional circumstances).

Patients presenting for Anticoagulation Clinic appointments and GTT testing will be prioritised where practicable.

Please note that patients may be seen more quickly at Hemel Hempstead than at Watford.
